The angular resolution is $9'$ over most of the map, including the entire Galactic plane, but is lower ($15'$ or $30'$) in some regions out of the plane (see Fig. 1 & Table 1). The sensitivity varies somewhat from region to region, since each component survey was integrated individually using moment masking or clipping in order to display all statistically significant emission but little noise (see §2.2). A dotted line marks the sampling boundaries, given in more detail in Fig. 1.
